26	Replace the wording for Rule #7 under "Rules for Entering State Show" A horse may not be used/ridden/handled in the same event for any age group including halter, showmanship, western, english, or speed events with the exception of family members or people living in the same household, who may use the same horse in same event in different age groups.	FAILED
27	Since there is a no drinking policy at Perry National Fairgrounds, if ay member of any club is seen drinking or intoxicated at an arena, in the alley way (Western or Speed), or anywhere close to the arena during an event, that club member should be asked to leave and not be able to return to a State Show. There should not be anyone that has been drinking, or is drinking (cup in hand) at the arena's while classes are in progress.	FAILED
28	The protest rule needs to be changed to state: A protest can be brought to the attention of the hosting club President/Federation President at any time while the State Show is still going. It does not matter if Western is done on Sunday. The state show does not officially end until the last person runs cloverleaf on Monday and all placings are announced. <b>DEEP DIXIE</b>		
39	Keep the current Chairman position and add two Co-Chairman positions. One to serve as Running and one to serve as Judged. These two individuals should be versed in their discipline and able to help with clarifying rules and any concerns that arise. They would work with the Chairman when issues arise so that we could help stop the mass emails to every President on issues that may not concern their particular discipline. This group could also serve as a "Rules Committee" to help in assuring all passed proposals are understood and added to the Rules as needed. 40	In Reaves Arena, during Running Events, block off the entrance to the steps behind the clock. This would help deter individuals from going up the stairs and sitting or walking thru that area. 41	In the running events do a tractor drive after every 18 riders no matter what association it falls in. When adding the 10th association, the prior method of dragging after every 3 associations does not work to give each association a fair advantage on top or bottom drag. 44	Determine and set a rule when the state show ends for each discipline or how long an individual has to present a protest. This was a concern at the 2017 show when a protest was brought on Pleasure after all Pleasure classes had ended.
