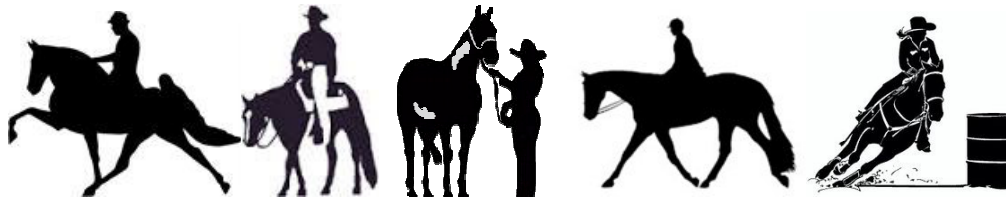

Paulding County Saddle Club 2025-2026 Show Season

On behalf of the dedicated members of the Paulding County Saddle Club, we bid you WELCOME to the show. It is our sincere desire to provide you with the best in equine activities, in a safe and fun environment. We hope your day here will be filled with fun and fellowship with your equine neighbors. You do not have to be a member to show in our open shows, but we do offer PCSC memberships that reduces your entry fees and include exclusive only events/benefits. We have Individual Memberships and Family Memberships available.

- Entry Fees are non-refundable unless there is a medical situation that prevents the rider of horse from entering the class.
- If you choose to run a "tab", you must leave an open signed check, payable to 'PCSC' at the time of registration.

SHOW RULES:

- **PCSC Rules** will be followed first. What PCSC doesn't cover, then AQHA or RHBAA rules will be in effect for acceptable gaits, equipment, tack, and attire.
- **Helmets** are required for Jumping. Helmets are recommended for all other classes, but not required, and no penalties will be assessed if worn.
- **Classes** are called in the following manner: Class entering the ring will be called with a 2-minute gate call after last call. The next class will be asked to report to the gate area, and the class following will be required to be getting ready.
- Once the show starts, the holding area will be for pre-staging classes only. Please do not work or lunge your horses in the gate area.
- **Trail Classes:** ALL riders may only enter one trail class in addition to the trail warm-up class. Five or more obstacles are set up and require maneuvering through the entire course. Maximum time at each prop is 60 seconds for exhibition.
- **Timed Events:** A 5 second penalty will be added for each prop knocked over. Failure to complete the pattern or lack of forward motion will be a disqualification. A \$10 fine will be assessed for any exhibition over 60 seconds.
- **Jumping** exhibition will have a time limitation of 60 seconds. There is a \$10 fine for going over the limit.
- All classes are classified as all western attire and tack or all English attire and tack with exception of Country Pleasure Racking and Trail Pleasure Racking (either English or Western allowed). No mixed tack/attire allowed in any class.
- **As evidence of my signature above, I and/or my child, agree to be photographed while attending the PCSC show. These photos may be used on our website, Facebook, and other forms of advertising/media. The photos will be used to promote PCSC.**

Descriptions

Mini & Low Hunter: Judged on style and correctness

Jumper: Judged on speed plus faults

Walk Only: Riders of any age, cannot cross enter into other riding classes.

- ❖ Can have trainer within 10' or attached to rider as needed.
- ❖ Judged on Rider's ability to "show" the horse.
- ❖ Riders may share horses for pattern/trail classes.
- ❖ Classes may be split if larger than 10 entries.

Assisted Beginner: Riders of any age, cannot cross enter Advanced or any group trot classes.

- ❖ Can have trainer within 10' or attached to rider as needed.
- ❖ Riders may share horses for pattern/showmanship/trail classes.
- ❖ Classes may be split if larger than 10 entries.

Advanced Beginner: Riders of any age, cannot cross enter into Assisted or any group canter classes.

- ❖ Can have trainer in arena more than 20' away from rider.
- ❖ Judged on Rider's ability to "show" the horse.
- ❖ Riders may share horses for pattern/showmanship/trail classes.
- ❖ Classes may be split if larger than 10 entries.

Youth & Adult English Pleasure and Equitation: Huntseat and Saddleseat.

Youth & Adult Western and Horsemanship: Pleasure and Ranch.

- ❖ Riders cannot cross enter into Walk Only/Beginner classes.
- ❖ Riders will ride in Open Trail, getting points from only one ride.

Award Divisions

- ❖ **WALK ONLY** – Points from Rail, Pattern & Trail (Leadline is not included)
- ❖ **ASSISTED Beginner** – Points from Assisted English Division, Assisted Western Division, Assisted Trail & Halter
- ❖ **ADVANCED Beginner** – Points from Advanced English Division, Advanced Western Division, Advanced Trail & Halter
- ❖ **Youth 19 & Under PLEASURE** – Youth English, Youth Western, Youth Trail, Showmanship & Halter
- ❖ **Adult 20 & Over PLEASURE** – Adult English, Adult Western, Adult Trail, Showmanship & Halter
- ❖ **Youth 19 & Under GAITED** – Youth Country Pleasure, Youth Trail Pleasure & Model
- ❖ **Adult 20 & Over GAITED** – Adult Country Pleasure, Adult Trail Pleasure & Model
